IN FUDDLE'S STORYBOOK, THE MONSTER WHO COULDN'T DECIDE, SHE MEETS A WORM WHO LOVES TO MAKE POSITIVE AFFIRMATION SIGNS IN THE GARDEN. LET'S MAKE OUR OWN GARDEN OF SIGNS!

### MATERIALS:

- 2-3 small potted plants or wild flower seeds
- Potting soil
- Scissors and glue sticks
- Poster board
- Popsicle sticks
- Markers and crayons

### STEP ONE: PLANTING THE GARDEN

- Plant seeds or flowers into small flower pots
- Add additional soil to ensure flowers or seeds have enough dirt to grow

### STEP TWO: MAKING THE SIGNS

- Cut out two to three ( or as many as you like) shapes from the poster board. Size can vary. We suggest approx 4".

BELOW WRITE THE ENCOURAGING MESSAGES YOU WOULD LIKE TO PUT ON YOUR SIGNS.

- Rewrite messages on your cut out signs and decorate
- Place a small spot of glue to the top of your Popsicle stick and attach the sign. Let the glue dry.
- Place the sign in the dirt with your plant.

### STEP THREE: TENDING TO YOUR GARDEN

- Place your garden of signs in med-full sun depending on the plants you have chosen.
- Water as needed
- Read each message to yourself when you need a little pick me up!
